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1. The 2007 comp plan has been generally followed.
 2. Community members are stepping up to implement change and be involved. i.e. Legacy Park, fireworks, etc.
 3. Survey from 2007 wants town to remain rural in feeling.
 - a. This committee recognizes growth is investable but controlled growth will be of most importance.
 4. 2022 survey should be trimmed to reduce redundancy.
 - a. Add newer ideas of green infrastructure, parks and recreation, electric charging stations, etc.
 - b. Survey reminder card can be inserted in sewer bill for \$70.
 5. Transportation
 - a. Major changes coming to Licking County Transit. Possible COTA merger.
 - b. Proposed roads could include:
 - i. Hanesview Drive connector to Echo Drive
 - ii. Access/frontage road on Mears Farm development to reduce curb cuts.

1. Predetermine access points at Flowers Drive and Meadow Drive.
 - iii. All newly built roads should have either sidewalk or multi use path.
 - iv. Village is working on concept drawings for W. High corridor.
 - c. Intersection upgrades include traffic circles at Hainsview/High, Legacy Park entrance/High and Hickman/High.
 - i. Include old ball field entrance within the Hickman/High intersection improvements.
6. County/Village looking at construction of water plant behind Legacy Park next to TJ Evans Trail as well as other options for central water supply.
