An Ordinance amending Ordinance 32-2025 to include a short-term rental permit fee on behalf of the Village of Hanover, Licking County, State of Ohio and declaring an emergency.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the VILLAGE OF HANOVER, County of Licking, State of Ohio:

**Ordinance 15-2026**

An Ordinance amending Ordinance 32-2026 to include a professional service review fee on behalf of the Village of Hanover, Licking County, State of Ohio and declaring an emergency.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the VILLAGE OF HANOVER, County of Licking, State of Ohio:

**WHEREAS**, Council previously adopted Ordinance 32-2026 establishing regulations and fees related to zoning and permitting within the Village; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Hanover incurs administrative and professional review costs associated with processing and evaluating certain permit applications, including short-term rental permits; and


**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to amend Ordinance 32-2026 to ensure that such costs are reasonably recovered through the establishment of appropriate fees; and

**WHEREAS**, the establishment of a professional service review fee will promote the efficient administration and enforcement of the Village's zoning regulations; and

**WHEREAS**, Council finds that adopting this amendment is in the best interest of the public health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Village of Hanover.

**Section 1:** That, this Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public health, safety and welfare. The emergency is necessary to administer the zoning resolution and will therefore take effect immediately upon its passage by Council and approval by Mayor.
