- Resolution 6-2026: A resolution of the Council of the Village of Hanover requesting the Licking County Auditor to certify to the Village the total current tax valuation of the Village and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the renewal of the current 1.5 mill tax levied for fire protection and emergency medical services purposes. Second Reading

Ordinance:

- Ordinance 17-2026: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS AND PROVIDING FOR ADDITIONAL ESTIMATED REVENUE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2026 ON BEHALF OF THE VILLAGE OF HANOVER, LICKING COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. - Ordinance 18-2026: AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR FISCAL OFFICER CONSULTANT SERVICES FOR THE VILLAGE OF HANOVER, LICKING COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO. First Reading
- Ordinance 19-2026: AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING ZOE MORAN TO THE POSITION OF VILLAGE FISCAL OFFICER FOR THE VILLAGE OF HANOVER, LICKING COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO. First Reading
